## DESCRIPTION/ORDERING INFORMATION

The SN74CB3T1G125 is a high-speed TTL-compatible FET bus switch with low ON-state resistance ( $r_{\text {on }}$ ), allowing for minimal propagation delay. The device fully supports mixed-mode signal operation on all data I/O ports by providing voltage translation that tracks $\mathrm{V}_{\mathrm{CC}}$. The SN74CB3T1G125 supports systems using 5-V TTL, 3.3-V LVTTL, and $2.5-\mathrm{V}$ CMOS switching standards, as well as user-defined switching levels (see Figure 1).

The SN74CB3T1G125 is a 1 -bit bus switch with a single ouput-enable ( $\overline{\mathrm{OE}}$ ) input. When $\overline{\mathrm{OE}}$ is low, the bus switch is ON, and the A port is connected to the B port, allowing bidirectional data flow between ports. When OE is high, the bus switch is OFF, and a high-impedance state exists between the $A$ and $B$ ports.

This device is fully specified for partial-power-down applications using $I_{\text {off. }}$. The $\mathrm{I}_{\text {off }}$ feature ensures that damaging current will not backflow through the device when it is powered down. The device has isolation during power off.
To ensure the high-impedance state during power up or power down, $\overline{O E}$ should be tied to $V_{C C}$ through a pullup resistor; the minimum value of the resistor is determined by the current-sinking capability of the driver.
